The Salt Lake Tribune says Utah's prison population is rising faster than any state but one



According to a survey conducted by Vera, Utah spends \$150+ million in state prison expenditures



The new Draper prison is expected to cost the state ~\$780 million

Instead of incarceration, The Other Side Academy is a training school to help convicts, substance abusers and homeless individuals rehabilitate their lives through a community and pro-social, vocational learning

The Other Side Academy had some of the most amazing things happen in 2018 as we have continued on our mission to grow and expand to save more lives!

We have grown our school in Utah by expanding our facilities. Our graduates continue to live a stable life free of crime. We have saved the State of Utah millions of dollars and hope to do the same as we expand into our second location in Denver, Colorado.

We saw our two main social enterprise training schools, The Other Side Movers, and The Other Side Thrift Boutique, continue to grow and maintain their status as the highest rated moving company and thrift store in their respective categories in terms of customer satisfaction.

Weekly, we have had individuals from the community, representing all walks of life, come share powerful, inspiring, touching, and sometime heartbreaking stories of their personal lives with our students. We have also given hundreds of tours to community leaders, business dignitaries, and religious leaders, including some of the top leadership of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints.

We have been humbled by the overwhelming support we have received from our donors, which have included both cash donations as well as in-kind donations of every variety imaginable. These donations have come from generous individuals, families, foundations, and businesses. Their help has helped accelerated our growth and ability to save more lives.

During the year, we became part of the Catalyst Network, run by Stand Together. Their mission is to find effective non-profits who are serving those on the margins and help them scale and grow. Stand Together did a video about Dave Durocher, our managing director, and his journey of transformation, and it has now been seen over 750,000 times across the nation and around the world.

Of course, our most important accomplishment is the individual transformation that is happening in the lives of our students. The model is working and we are seeing our graduates go out, rejoin society, become employed, and become productive, crime-free members of their communities, reuniting with their families. Some of our graduates have elected to stay a 3rd year to continue to grow and be leaders in the house. A portion of these 3rd year graduates have been selected to be staff-in-training candidates so they can help us provide leadership to new sites in the future.

About The Other Side Academy (TOSA)

The Other Side Academy is a life skills and vocational training school for those who've hit rock bottom

It is a school where our students learn vocational, pro-social, and life skills so they can succeed on "the other side." It's a school where students can gain their GED, learn marketing skills, business skills, and gain experience in various trades. Our students learn how to make and keep promises and how to live life with integrity, accountability, and with love. Our students have the opportunity to learn to work in our various vocational training schools, such as The Other Side Movers and The Other Side Thrift Boutique. Graduate may choose to continue work at Upside Enterprises or continue on to our graduate program

Our school is for men and women, many of whom have lived a lifetime of addiction and criminal behavior, who now want to learn a better way to live. The Other Side Academy is available for these men and women pre- and post- sentencing and those within the jails and prisons in the state of Utah. We are also open to ex-convicts, substance abusers, homeless, and others who walk in off the street.

The Other Side Academy is a place for those who want to make a better life for themselves and who are willing to put in the work to change their destructive behavior. It's a place where they will be supported by those who have come before them, and where they will be expected to support those who come after. It's a place where "as A helps B, A gets better." It's a place where honesty is at the core of everything we do and where hard work, especially on ourselves, pays off. The Other Side Academy is a place where the most lost among us can change our lives to a life free from addiction, crime and destruction, to one full of honesty, empathy, and accountability.

The Twelve Beliefs

1 You alone can do it, but you can't do it alone

We grow as we learn to truly connect for the first time in our lives. Community is the antidote to personal alienation. The way out is to let others in.

2 Make and keep promises

The only requirement for entry to The Other Side Academy is a sincere desire to change. To change from the inside out we must learn a completely new set of habits and skills. We are here because we asked to come - and made a promise to do our best.

3 Self-reliance. There is no free lunch

We support ourselves – and keep our doors open for others who wish to change their lives by running businesses. It's pretty simple, if we don't work we don't eat.

4 Impeccable honesty

Many of us have lived both inside and out- side of jails, prisons, and rehab programs and have perfected skills of lying, manipulating and using those around us. While at The Other Side Academy you will learn and be expected to practice impeccable honesty about your actions, thoughts and feelings.

5 Act as if

As self-discipline, hard work and rigorous honesty become new habits they begin to create feelings of self-worth, peace and happiness. Until then, we "act as if" we are honest, caring, curious, and humble. Over time we become that which we habitually do.

6 Embrace humility

One of the most difficult gifts The Other Side Academy family gives us is feedback. Our job is to help others see the truth about themselves. To be aware is to be alive. Humility accelerates awareness.

We set strong boundaries to develop the muscle to change our lives.

Faith friendly



We are supportive of any beliefs that help you lead a healthier and more connected life. We are not a 12-step program and we support each other in worshipping or not worshipping according to our own conscience.


The Other Side Movers | The #1 Rated Moving Company in Salt Lake City


